The only part of our company that did not participate directly in this project was our concrete division!

We also used many of our sub-contractors on the project: Beyer Cabinets built the wheel assemblies and provided exterior panel materials; La Crosse Glass Co., provided the Lexan for the skylight and windows; Dale's Drywall and Painting provided the paint and painting crew; Sign Pro of La Crosse provided and applied the graphics. This was definitely an all-hands effort!"

The idea for the Pearl Street Brewery replica playhouse sprang from the fact that Pearl Street Brewery is partnering with Habitat for Humanity to host this year's Raise the Roof Concert fundraiser. We wanted to contribute something that would be a valuable and desirable raffle item, but we also wanted to do something unique. Replicating Pearl Street Brewery's mascot Grumman vehicle fit the bill perfectly!

Plus, they will also donate a "regular" playhouse in the spring to the latest Habitat for Humanity build," said Plourde.
